Soldering Workshop

A soldering workshop will be held <u>after</u> this month's meeting at the Community Center. If you want to brush up on your soldering skills, Joe Dantonio will be conducting training and demonstrations.





Please bring with you to the meeting, your soldering equipment and something to practice soldering on. This could be lengths of wire typically used in RC applications, an old flight controller or ESC, and especially battery and ESC connectors. If bringing connectors, be sure to bring both the male and female sides.

Again, this soldering training will take place AFTER the meeting so plan on staying a bit later than usual. First aid kits are optional!
